The Scholarship Foundation of Erie Scottish Rite Bodies proudly announces its 40th annual scholarship program. The Scholarship Foundation has granted awards to men and women from Erie and Crawford Counties to assist and encourage the pursuit of higher education. Awards are intended for students pursuing bachelor or graduate degrees from accredited colleges and universities. Award amounts are expected to range from \$750 to \$2,000.

A not-for-profit corporation, the Scholarship Foundation has been nurtured through the generous patronage of members and friends of Scottish Rite.

Please note that scholarship awards are paid directly to the school in the student's name. Students do not have to repay these awards. Students should learn from their other sources of financial assistance whether a scholarship will affect financial assistance.

Scholarships will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Financial need
- Academic achievement
- Essay
- Extra curricular activities
- Educational/career objective

Application Requirements

- 1. Applicants must be a high school graduate by July 1, 2020.
- 2. Applicants must be a resident of Erie or Crawford County, Pennsylvania.
- 3. Scholarship awards are for applicants pursuing bachelor or graduate degrees from accredited colleges and universities. Associate or similar degrees are not eligible.
- 4. To be considered, an application must be complete, signed by you and a Scottish Rite sponsor, and include an essay, grade transcript(s) and FAFSA information. You must complete the entire application. If you cannot complete a blank, explain why, e.g. "Did not take SAT". If information changes (e.g., you plan to attend a different school), please send us a letter with the new information.
- 5. An application **must** be sponsored by a current member of the Erie Scottish Rite. Sponsorship requires that the member review and sign the application. Sponsorship is limited to three applications per member.
- 6. Completed applications must be postmarked by **April 1**, **2020** and mailed to:
